
Directions



Seoul Clinic is located at Ssolema Building 10th floor

1. Airport limousine bus (Takes about 50 min, Cost 7,000 won)

Doctor can take the limousine bus from Gimhae International Airport and get off at Nampodong (Phoenix hotel) and walks around 230m (2 minutes) to Seoul clinic.



2. Taxi (Takes about 50 min, Cost 20,000 won)

Airport (Gimhae) > get off at Daedong pharmacy

Seoul Clinic is located at 10th floor of the building opposite the pharmacy.

3. Subway (Takes about 1 hour, Cost 2,000 won)

- 1) Take Busan Gimhae Light rail transit from airport and change to subway Line 2 (Green line) at Sasang Station.
- 2) Take Line 2 to Jangsan direction and change to line 1 (Orange line) at Seomyeon Station.
- 3) Take Line 1 to Sinpyeong direction and get off at Nampo Station.
- 4) Take Exit 1 and walk around 2 minutes to the clinic.
